Rodrigo Calderón

Born in El Salvador, Rodrigo Calderón studied a bachelor of Dramatic Arts from Universidad del Salvador in Argentina; and has since immersed himself in directing, teaching, performing, and investigating different movement-based forms that potentialize the possibilities of the performer's body as a communicative and political tool.

At the beginning of his career, he intensively experimented with César Pineda the ritualistic nature of theatre, an experience that deeply inspired him to continue investigating the expressive possibilities of the actor's body to create a ceremonial gathering. Rodrigo's theatrical practice focuses on the building of a community. *HE* is Rodrigo's debut work as a playwright.

Synopsis

HE tells the story of a man who returns to his childhood home, a small coastal town in postcivil war El Salvador — a place he swore to the ocean he'd never set foot in again.

Twenty years have passed. Drenched with salt water, the man babbles a question to the ocean. "Do you remember?" He tells the ocean, and the audience, stories of his childhood—the exquisite spiced fish his grandma cooked, the vile jokes his dad loved telling to his ex-army buddies, the forbidden story his mum asked his grandma never to tell him, and about the time he was almost drowned by the ocean.

Style

Intimate poetic storytelling, physical theatre, direct audience address, magic realism.

Themes

Masculinity and manhood, coming-of-age, intergenerational trauma, sexuality and homophobia, and love.

Post-Show Q&A

Playwright and performer Rodrigo Calderón is available for post-show Q&As in multiple formats ranging from informal meet and greets, community incursions, or an allocated panel discussion at the venue. Q&As are excellent tools to deepen the audience's understanding of the work and its themes and the playwright's process of writing and creating *HE*.

The Actor's Ensemble Practice

In the "Actor's Ensemble Practice", participants explore the principles of Meyerhold Biomechanics and Suzuki Method For Actor's training, practising a hybrid of physical exercises that enhance the bodyawareness. These workshops run by performer Rodrigo Calderón are suitable for industry professionals and students of acting, dance, circus, or other physical-based disciplines. Workshops can be delivered as a once-off masterclass or a series of workshops.

Theatrical Writing for the Actor

Playwright and performer Rodrigo Calderón shares his unique approach to theatrical-writing, writing in a second language, and practical exercises for the development of script-writing. This workshop is a one-off three hour masterclass.

Crew required from venue

Pre-rig is required unless negotiated. Crewing figures may be negotiable for smaller venues.

Stage

The performance features a solo performer who utilises a rope swing in different ways throughout. The swing ropes are natural fibre and are set approximately 400mm wide. It is used to partially bear the weight of the performer and also to fully bear the weight of the performer. When used in a full weight bearing manner, it is only used as a swing apparatus. i.e. only to sit or stand on the wooden seat while swinging lightly.

The swing apparatus has been approved at a minimum WLL of 600kg. This is operating at approximately a 6:1 safety ratio. This more than satisfies the requirements of the performance.

Venue to supplyA sufficient anchor point to satisfy the minimum required load on the
swing of 700kg or 7kn.If the venue anchor points are wider than the necessary 400mm
spread, a suitable steel spreader bar will need to be supplied in order
to act as an intermediary between the venue anchor points and the
anchor points of the swing ropes.A rigger with an intermediate or advanced rigging licence to sign off
on the installation of the swing to the anchor point.Company to provideWooden swing to be installed onto the anchor point.

Lighting

The show utilises house stock from a standard rig (essentially require an isolated front wash and side wash, ideally with LED stock). LX operated by touring Stage Manager, from standard FoH position.
